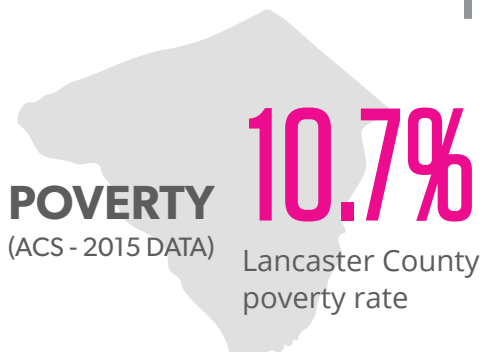
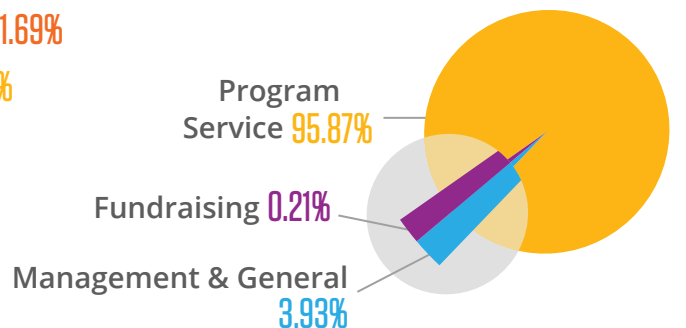
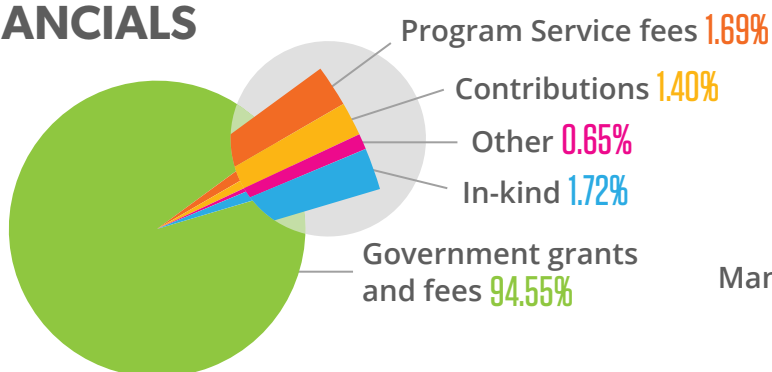

### INVESTING IN EARLY CHILDHOOD

**98** Children received affordable, high quality child care in our **STAR 4 CENTER.**

### STRENGTHENING FAMILIES

**131** Families received early literacy and parent training through **1415 HOME VISITS.**

### PROMOTING SELF-SUFFICIENCY

**7,335** Households were approved for utility assistance programs.

**9,581** new mothers, infants and young children improved their health and nutrition in the WIC program.

**236** Survivors of domestic violence received emergency shelter and **500 RECEIVED EMERGENCY LEGAL SERVICES.**

**53** Clients were referred to Navigation in just 6 months.

**761** Head Start students received pre-kindergarten services.

**2,388,991** Pounds of food and fresh produce were distributed to local food pantries and feeding programs through CAP and partner, Central PA Food Bank.

**124** Older adults were connected with peers, recreation and other supportive services at the Senior Centers.
