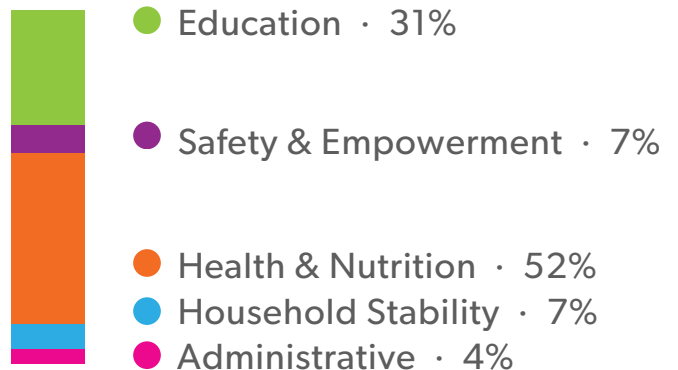


FINANCIALS
